Your hospital is a 22-bed acute care facility providing emergency care 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, as well as ambulatory care, outpatient clinics, physiotherapy and diagnostic imaging services.

Healthy Futures. Together! Comprehensive Capital Campaign

A completely new Emergency Department and five-year plan to improve Patient Care and Clinical Equipment.

Campaign Goal: \$4 Million

Currently, the hospital requires more than 100 pieces of patient care equipment totaling approximately \$2 Million. Individual pieces of life-saving equipment can range from \$2,500 to \$200,000 dollars EACH. This equipment will be used throughout the hospital including in the new Emergency Department.

New Emergency Department

This is not a renovation. This is an entirely new, state of the art facility built on the existing property and attached to the hospital. A brand new Emergency Department building will sit on the current helicopter pad area, and will be triple the size of the current Emergency Department.

How will the new Emergency Department improve each patient's experience?

- The new Emergency Department will be linked to the hospital and will address current space challenges. It includes, 11 treatment spaces, which is an increase of five (83%) over the current ED.
- The new ED offers flexible space which is better able to adapt to peak volume periods.
- Includes a new ambulance and barrier-free, walk-in entrances.
- Features enhanced infection control standards.
- Includes a private family room and dedicated space for patients dealing with mental health concerns.
- There will be a dedicated space for women with obstetrical/gynecological health concerns.
- Includes a larger waiting room and additional washrooms.

Where is the Hospital with the planning of the new Emergency Department?

CPDMH is now in the final stages of design, with the next stage being the tendering process.

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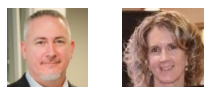

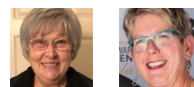

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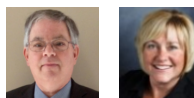
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
