In 1994 the Carleton Place & District Memorial (CPDMH) Foundation was incorporated by the province of Ontario and registered with Revenue Canada as a charitable organization. The CPDMH Foundation is a non-profit organization, led by a dedicated volunteer Board of Directors. Our goal is to provide the hospital with funding that is otherwise not covered through the Ministry of Health.

The CPDMMH Foundation was established to strengthen the hospital's ability to provide high quality health care for patients in Carleton Place and surrounding communities. We offer opportunities to support the purchase of safe, quality patient care equipment, staff education, research and development and renovations and redevelopment to our Hospital and we are accountable to our donors, stewarding with respect, integrity and transparency.

OUR MISSION: To enhance patient care at the Carleton Place and District Memorial Hospital by encouraging philanthropic giving through fundraising along with the prudent management of donor funds.

OUR VISION: To meet the needs of the Carleton Place & District Memorial Hospital by building a legacy of support through continual philanthropic effort.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT OF REVENUES, EXPENSES AND CONTRIBUTIONS FOR THE 12-MONTH PERIOD ENDING MARCH 31, 2015

In 2014-2015 the Foundation was able to provide the hospital with \$232,188 in funding for vital patient care equipment. Some of the equipment purchased included a flexible video colonoscope for the operating and recovery room, a THERE-Vital Active/Passive exerciser in the physiotherapy department, IV pumps used throughout the hospital, a mobile ultrasound machine, several smaller pieces of equipment required by various departments, as well as various staff education requirements. Funds totalling \$200,000 will be used towards the purchase of the new digital x-ray machine coming in the 2015-2016 fiscal year for the diagnostic imaging department.
