OUR HISTORY

20 years ago in 1994, the Carleton Place & District Memorial Hospital (CPDMH) Foundation was incorporated by the province of Ontario and registered with Revenue Canada as a charitable organization. The CPDMH Foundation is a non-profit organization, led by a dedicated volunteer Board of Directors from the community. Our goal is to provide the hospital with funding that is otherwise not covered through the Ministry of Health.

OUR MISSION: To enhance patient care at the Carleton Place and District Memorial Hospital by encouraging philanthropic giving through fundraising along with the prudent management of donor funds.

OUR VISION: To meet the needs of the Carleton Place & District Memorial Hospital by building a legacy of support through continual philanthropic effort.

OUR VALUES: The CPDMH Foundation will:

- clearly explain our priorities and the purpose for which we are raising funds;
- be fiscally responsible with the donations/gifts entrusted to us by our donors;
- act with integrity, honesty and openness;
- ensure that donor funds are used effectively for the purpose for which they were given;
- respect the privacy of our donors by not selling or exchanging their anonymity;
- conduct ourselves with sensitivity and professionalism.

Donors help make the difference between good health care and the outstanding care offered at the Carleton Place & District Memorial Hospital. The CPDMH Foundation was established to strengthen the hospital's ability to provide high quality health care for patients in Carleton Place and surrounding communities. We offer opportunities to support the purchase of safe, quality patient care equipment, staff education, research and development and renovations and redevelopment to our Hospital and we are accountable to our donors, stewarding with respect, integrity and transparency.

CPDMH cares for more than 29,000 patients*, their families and friends every year. In fact, at any given moment at CPDMH, compassionate care is being given, health care professionals are learning and advancing their skills, and medical procedures are taking place that are benefiting patients here – with quality health care close to home.

*Last year 170 staff, 18 Local Physicians, 29 Emergency Department Physicians and 36 Visiting Specialists at CPDMH had 519 Admissions, over 11,000 Clinic Visits and 18,000 Emergency Department Patients.



WE ARE DONORS TOO

At the CPDMH Foundation, we work with donors to support the outstanding doctors, nurses and staff at CPDMH as they make a difference in the lives of patients and their families. We understand our donors' commitment to health care because we are donors too.

The CPDMH Foundation Board of Directors and our Foundation staff member lead by example by the donations they make each year. Many CPDMH Board of Trustees and staff members are also supporters through their monthly giving and payroll deductions. 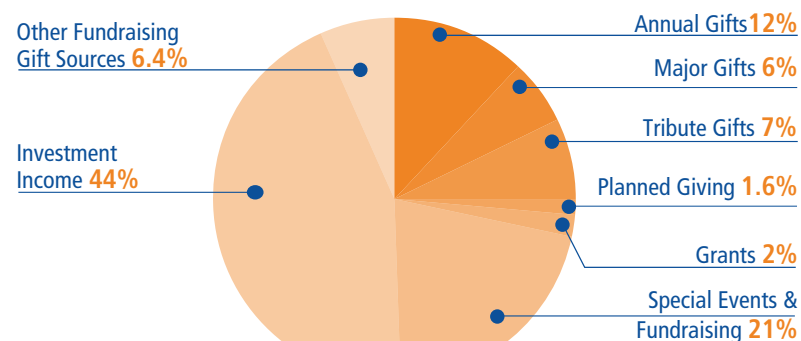
FINANCIAL STATEMENT OF REVENUES, EXPENSES AND CONTRIBUTIONS FOR THE 12-MONTH PERIOD ENDING MARCH 31, 2014

Patient Care Equipment purchased this year by the Foundation included a video colonoscope for the operating and recovery room, an IV smart pump and wheelchair for use throughout the hospital, specialized POCHI-POC blood testing equipment, a flexible nasalarayngoscope for paediatric care, an operating room head lamp, a typanometer (required for inner ear measurements), a THERA-Vital active/passive exerciser for the physiotherapy department and over \$200,000 towards the purchase of replacement x-ray equipment for the diagnostic imaging department.

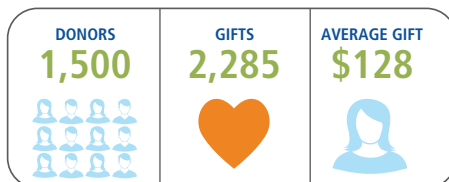

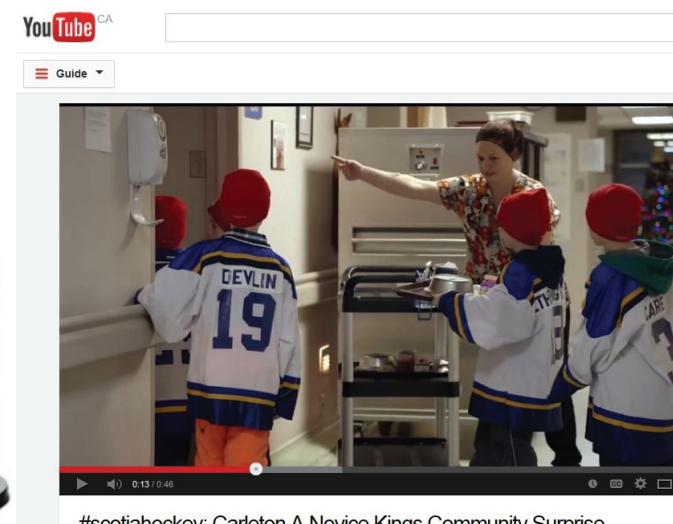
